Activities (2018 – 2019)

N.S.S. units work towards the motto ‘Not me But You’

The N.S.S. Volunteers should enroll themselves as members for a period of two years and are expected to participate regularly in the activities organized by the unit. Every Volunteer will be issued a Certificate after completion of 2 years who must attend the 7 days Annual Special Camp. The spectrum of activities during camp include organizing Medical camps, health and hygiene programmes for the poor and the needy and for the betterment of rural areas.

The National Service Scheme offers opportunities for service, to develop character, team spirit and leadership qualities. It creates a way to social awareness.

Assessment of NSS volunteers will be done by the NSS Programme Officer concerned and an external Programme Officer as recommended by the NSS Co-ordinator, Bharathiar University.

The two year period of participation of the students in the NSS will be evaluated for a maximum of 100 marks and they will be awarded the Degree based on the marks scored by them.

- On 21.06.2018, 100 NSS volunteers participated in the ‘International Yoga Day’ Celebration in our college. Dr. Rev. Sr. Pauline Mary Helen, Principal Nirmala College for Women, Coimbatore, inaugurated the function. Mrs. K. Eshwari, Ex-DEO, Erode and her team from Heartfulness Meditation Institute Coimbatore addressed the gathering on ‘Meditation and its Significance in day-to-day life’. Later Mrs. Semmalar Devi and Ms. Dhanamani from the World Community Service Centre, Coimbatore demonstrated the Volunteers on ‘Yoga for Human Excellence’.

- On 26.06.2018, 120 NSS volunteers participated in a Awareness Rally against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking from YRC Building to V.O.C. Park, Coimbatore.



- On 29.06.2018, In connection with “Go Green Campaign” a 'Human Chain formation was organized from Kamaraj Road via Sungam to Sanmugam Road Coimbatore.
- On 06.07.2018, 8 NSS Volunteers visited Kangayam Palayam Village, Sullur and conducted a survey on the common facilities available for the Village.
- On 17.07.2018 the Inaugural Function of the NSS was held. Dr.E.R.Miriam, Associate Professor in Geography, Nirmala College for Women,Coimbatore briefed the volunteers on “NSS and its Significance”.
- From 18.07.2018 to 27.07.2018, Our volunteers participated in the Swachh Bharat Summer Internship Programme at Kangayampalayam Sullur.The

students helped in cleaning the Panchayat Office, Government Higher Secondary School, Anganwadi Schools, Primary Health Centers, Ration Shops, Water Tanks etc.. They depicted the significance of Swachh Bharat and Sanitation through wall painting. The students took door to door awareness campaign and telecasted documentary films on Sanitation, Dengue Fever, Rain Water Harvest, personal hygiene, effects of open defecation, importance of the construction of toilets, usage of clean water etc... The volunteers cleaned the Toilets in Government Hr. Sec School Coimbatore, white washed 3 toilets, and dug 2 compost pit in the school.



- From 06.08.2018 to 14.08.2018, 300 NSS volunteers observed “Swachhtha Pakhwara Week”. Volunteers cleaned the college campus, Kamaraj Road, Bus Stop, visited the orphanage run by the sisters of Missionaries of Charity, Puliakulam and served them. Mr.Gowtham and team from National Agenda Forum, Hyderabad addressed the volunteers on ‘Gandhi’s 18 Points Constructive Programmes’.Dr.Mrs. Mercy Aanandaraj, Associate Professor in History & Dean, Student Affairs, Nirmala College for Women, Coimbatore administered the oath on Swachh Bharat to the students.
- On 31.08.2018 “Smart City Programme” was conducted for all the NSS volunteers of our College. Mr. Ruban Thangaraj, Additional Collector, Smart City Programme ,Coimbatore encouraged the students to participate in the smart city voting campaign.

Dengue, Swatchh Bharath and plastic free village. Free Eye and Ortho Medical camp was organized. 1000 seed balls were made by our volunteers and more than 150 tree saplings were planted in the village. Self employment programmes were conducted for women.
