- The Meeting commenced with the welcome address by Dr Pauline Vasanthi Joseph, IQAC Coordinator.
- Dr. K. Sumathi Alumni Associate Professor of Mathematics, PSGR

- Krishnammal College for Women, Coimbatore offered to render help in all the activities related to curriculum, skill oriented courses and student centered learning and online courses for students.
- Suggestions offered to enhance the syllabus in order to equip skills in the students.
 - Teachers have to be equipped with orientation and training programmes to educate the students.
 - Steps should be taken to introduce more skill oriented and online courses and it should be made mandatory for students.
 - Each student should complete two online courses before the completion of the courses and extra credit marks should be given.
 - Faculty who are interested can register themselves for online courses and update themselves in the subject.
 - Teaching, learning strategies can be implementing by initiating online examinations.
 - Open book system. Considering the practical difficulties, the system was not advised by the members. But suggestions were given to conduct it on a trial basis for the PG students if desired.
 - E content teaching should be introduced for all subjects. Teachers who are efficient should be identified and training should be provided for them.

- Student perception strategies which are feasible should be implemented.
- Feedback system can be analyzed through HOD's and given to the Principal.
- Extension work can be rendered by offering computer literacy programmes and providing life skill programs for the dropout students.
- Innovations cannot be made mandatory for the sake of documentation every year.
- The members advised to identify a particular component and focus on the component on all spheres.
