The minutes of the previous meeting held on 16.7.2020 was read by Dr. Sr. Helen, Secretary of the Governing Body, and it was passed by all the members.

The implementations of the resolution passed in the previous meeting were reviewed.

The discussions went on as per the agenda and the following resolutions were passed.

1. It was announced that Mrs. Periyannayagammal, Supportive Staff retires on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2021 and Dr. Sr. Helen Associate Professor in



Mathematics and Principal retires on 31st May 2021.

It was resolved that an advertisement will be given in the newspaper in the first week of June 2021 in order to fill the vacancies arise due to the retirement in the department of mathematics.

The Principal Dr. S. Helen presented the activities of the college in the Governing Body meeting on 29.12.2020.

i 1. Activities during Lockdown.

a, The Principal presented that 2127 webinars, 1431 FDP, 204 Short Term Courses, 194 online Training Programme and 1104 Quizzes were attended by the faculty members during the Lockdown period.

b. Similarly, 90 webinars and 20 FDPs were organized by various departments of the college.

c. 29 of the faculty members have served as resource persons for other colleges during the lockdown.

ii Activities based on Theme of the college for the academic year 2020-2021.

(a) The Principal informed the members about the theme of the college for the academic year which was "Human Excellence Our Life Breath" and many activities were done under the theme.

(b) During the complete lock down period, food was prepared in the college premises and distributed to the needy from 31st March 2020 to

17th May 2020, and it was highly appreciated by the Commissioner of Coimbatore Corporation. The total amount spent for this project was Rs. 12,00,000/- (Twelve Lakhs)

(C) A total of 9 villages were adopted by the College and the following services were offered to the villagers.

(i) All the 300 families were given vegetables bags of 10 kg each.

(ii) Extension activities done in the adopted villages by each department in terms and each department gave awareness programs and donated rice, provisions, toilet articles etc.

(iii) Donation of Albizia amara (Arappu) powder making machines.

(iv) Diwali was celebrated with the villagers by distribution of sweets, clothes, vegetables and the required items.

III Initiatives of the college.

(a) The Principal notified that new initiatives such as instigation of start-up named Yuva Nirmala in the college. The aim of the startup is to extend services to the public in the form of counselling, Tutoring etc along with "Earn while you learn" benefit for the students.

b. The Principal apprised that a new journal named "International Journal of Humanities



and sciences" was initiated for Publication with 60 articles under processing.

(c) Another initiative to support the faculty members for research, SEED money scheme, was introduced in the college, with selection of 10 proposals with a support of Rs. 10,000/- each for a period of 6 months.

(d) The college has successfully registered the Entrepreneurship Development cell (EDC) and has signed a tie-up with AIC-RAISE. Under this initiative, 50 EDC student members are offered training for 16 weeks and commencement of Incubation centre in the college shortly.

#### iv Initiatives in the Curriculum.

(a) The Principal briefed out the initiatives taken in curriculum such as validation by foreign experts, introduction of blended learning method of teaching.

(b) A new course named "Cyber Security" is introduced for VA Students and "Digital Security" is introduced for PG Students. These two books were compiled by the faculty of Computer Science department with ISBN number.

#### v Students' Achievements.

(a) The Principal announced that nine students were selected under "French Learning through Interaction Programme" and has the opportunity to collaborate with the students of University of New Caledonia (French Territory) from Nov. 2020 onwards.

(b) The Principal apprised that Ms. Nimisha of II M.Sc Botany was selected for two months internship at Kerala State level Council, Trivandrum, Sponsored by Ministry of Environment and Climate Change. Similarly, Ms. Kavipriya II M.A Economics has received Rs. 5000/- as sponsorship from South Indian Bank for her Master thesis project.

#### VI Students' Achievements in Sports.

(a) The Principal proudly informed that the college Taekwondo team has bagged overall first place in Bharathiar University Intercollegiate tournament on 02.01.2020.

(b) The college hall badminton players K. Moha of III Economics, J. Ranjya of II Botany, M. Has of II Botany, L. Asokia Preethi of II Botany and D. Sowmiya Mary of II BBA were selected and represented Bharathiar University team and secured III<sup>rd</sup> place in the All India JNU University Ball Badminton tournament which held at Andhra University, Vishakapatnam from 07.01.2020 to 10.01.2020.

(c) The Principal announced that Mr. S. Kiruba of I M.Sc mathematics secured first place with a cash prize of Rs. 10,000/- in Tamil Nadu Inter University weightlifting tournament which was held at Manonmaniam Sundaranar University on 24.01.2020.

(d) Totally 33 students of the college has



represented Bharathiar University at South zone, All India Inter university level in various events conducted by Association of Indian University during this period.

- (e) Another feather to the cap of Nilimala College when Mr. A. Arthi of T. History represented <sup>Coimbatore</sup> district and secured 2<sup>nd</sup> place with a cash prize of Rs. 7500/- in the state level CM Trophy kabaddi tournament which was held at Madurai from 13.03.2020 to 15.3.2020.
