2. Thrust Concept for post graduate students is to inculcate Research knowledge. Students should be aware of the research concepts, cases which forms the liberalised domain for upliftment.
  3. Assessment pattern to be designed to bring out the skills expected under outcome based Education
  4. More Job oriented Courses to be introduced to Students. More with industry to conduct Job oriented Courses

Dr. Sangeetha recommended Course Curriculum

1. to be designed to foster innovation and Creativity for Students.

Dr. Baba Gnanakumar applauded the dedicated effort of the faculty in framing the outcome based Syllabi with topics f.o and blended learning.

1. As per the expectation of the New Education policy he suggested to introduce career oriented Courses in V & VI Semesters with 2 credits like Campus to Corporate and public policy Courses.
2. He endorsed open book system. Each programme can offer one open book system.
3. He recommended 100% Evaluation of Skill based Course of which 50% on Internal examination & 50% on Experiential learning.



4. Alumni can be encouraged to handle classes to give practical exposure in the latest trends in their fields.

Dr. Mary Nana M, Assistant Professor of the English department thanked the members of the academic Council for their cooperation, support and valuable suggestions.

It was proposed and accepted by the members the change in the CIA and end Semester mark pattern to be 40: 60.
