## Board of Studies 2020-2021

The Board of Studies Meeting of the Department of Economics was held on 30.01.2021 through Virtual Mode and the following resolutions were made:

#### **I. U.G. - B.A. Economics**

The board resolved to adopt the following changes in B.A Economics Programme.

1. In Semester I Allied: Banking Law and Practice, Priority Sector Lending (PSL) has been included in Unit IV, in order to gain knowledge about the financial assistance provided to the few specific sectors.
2. In Semester II Allied: Environmental Economics, National Green Tribunal (NGT) Act 2010 has been incorporated in Unit V so as to have awareness on issues related to environmental pollution and to handle various environmental disputes.
3. Core Course Tamil Nadu Economy was introduced in III Semester and Core Course Agricultural Economy of India in IV Semester
4. In Semester III Allied Course - Computer Systems I has been changed as Allied Course - Computer Systems - Theory and Allied Course - Computer Systems - Practicals has been introduced instead of Allied Course - Computer Systems II in IV Semester.
5. In Semester V the course Elective- Social and Economic Issues in India has been introduced as an option for Elective- History of Economic Thought under Choice Based Credit System.
6. General Economics was introduced as Inter-disciplinary/Non Major Elective course in V Semester
7. In Semester VI Human Resource Management has been offered as an Optional Elective Course for Elective- Entrepreneurial Development.

#### **II. P.G. - M.A. Economics**

The board resolved to adopt the modified curriculum for M.A Economics Programme. The following changes were made:

- Two Elective Courses Health Economics and Gender Economics has been introduced in Semester I under the Choice Based Credit System.

- In Semester II Elective Courses Foreign Trade Procedures and Documentation as well as Managerial Economics were introduced under Choice Based Credit System.
- In Semester III Core Course Entrepreneurship Development was replaced with the Course Management of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) as an Elective Course. An Elective course Economics of Infrastructure has been introduced under the Choice Based Credit System in Semester III.
- In Semester IV Demography and Labour Economics were introduced as Core Courses.
- In Semester IV Elective Course Intellectual Property Rights was introduced under Choice Based Credit System.
- The Internship Training has been incorporated in the end of the first year.

### **III. B.Com (Aided), B.Com (CA) and M.Com Courses**

1. For I B.Com the Allied Courses Business Economics in II Semester and Indian Economy in I Semester has been interchanged with few changes.
2. For I B.Com (CA) the Allied Courses Business Economics in II Semester and Public Finance in I Semester has been interchanged with minor changes.
3. Business Economics Course for I M Com in I semester has been renamed as Managerial Economics with few modification.
